We would like to formally advise you that Y & Y TRADING PTY LTD AS AUSTRALIA EWASTE RECYCLING has made a voluntary decision to discontinue participation in the R2 (Responsible Recycling) certification program, effective [10/04/2026].

This decision follows a long-term internal review of our certification strategy and governance framework, which has been ongoing since 2023. During this review, we identified substantial overlap between the R2 program requirements and other management system certifications and compliance frameworks already implemented within our organization.

Based on this assessment, we concluded that maintaining R2 certification no longer provides incremental governance or risk-control value relative to its administrative and contractual scope. The decision reflects a certification-strategy alignment. R2 certification is a voluntary, contractual third-party program and does not constitute a legal or regulatory authorization to operate. Our decision to discontinue R2 certification does not affect our legal compliance status, operational integrity, or commitment to responsible material management.

Y & Y TRADING PTY LTD AS AUSTRALIA EWASTE RECYCLING continues to operate in full compliance with all applicable environmental, trade, and export regulations in the jurisdictions in which we conduct business. Where downstream processing or recycling activities are involved, we continue to work with partners operating under applicable local legal and regulatory requirements, supported by contractual controls and due-diligence processes.

Should you require clarification or wish to discuss alternative assurance mechanisms that provide equivalent risk control within the scope of our services, we would be pleased to engage.
